Total participants for IC-24 were 245 and total 159 research papers were received from PAN India and abroad from the academicians, research scholars and students. These papers were divided into 14 tracks as per the domain. Out of 14, 2-2 tracks were from finance, marketing, general management; three tracks were based on students' research papers and rest one from each domain i.e., Economics and International Business, Information Technology, Law.
