


Fig: Chart depicting the employer feedback on curriculum for the year 2018-19.




Fig: Chart depicting the employer feedback on curriculum for the year 2017-18.




Fig: Chart depicting the employer feedback on curriculum for the year 2016-17.




Fig: Chart depicting the employer feedback on curriculum for the year 2015-16.




Fig: Chart depicting the employer feedback on curriculum for the year 2014-15.
