NAAC has touched every stakeholder of higher education in one way or the other, either directly or indirectly and 'Quality' has become the buzzword on the academic campuses today. During its existence of more than two decades, NAAC has also networked with the Central Government, State Governments, other higher education agencies and policy making bodies in the country to recognise the output of NAAC and use the accreditation grade as an important facilitative tool. With its rich experience of conducting more than eleven thousand accreditation visits, the NAAC is poised to give a new direction to the Quality Assurance process in India. UGC envisages to accredit every institution in India with a minimum score of 2.5 CGPA by the year 2022. This can be an achievable target only with involvement of colleges who have been accredited by NAAC with more than 3.26 CGA as mentors. Hence your institution has been identified as one.

NAAC has prepared a detailed work plan for the same. The preliminary task for a mentor institution is to identify at least 10 non-accredited colleges in the geographic vicinity of your institution.
