

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

LECTURES

Timings - Students are advised to follow the timings as displayed on the Notice Boards. Students will be allowed to enter the class up to five minutes from the commencement of the class. Beyond this, the entry into the class is discretion of the faculty.

ATTENDANCE

Since professional programs require students to attend the classes regularly, the students are encouraged by awarding them marks in each subject/course in which they have 75 percent and above attendance. Students having less than 75 percent attendance not only looses the marks but may also be detained from appearing in Internal Test/Semester Examination.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Participants may be granted a leave of absence only for the following reasons:

- Please note that the maximum period of absence allowed in any case, can be of 3 days only.
- Illness of self or sudden serious illness of parents, spouse or child (with proof).
- Sudden demise of parents, spouse or child.
- Marriage of self and sibling. (Invitation card need to be appended) along with application of leave.
- The participants are allowed to participate in competitions organized by selected reputed institutes. The total period of absence cannot exceed 5 days (altogether), if it is a national level competition.
- The participant should inform class coordinator prior of taking leaves in



written mode; the same will be approved by the programme coordinator.

- Participants will not be granted leave for pursuing any other courses or for giving any other examination during the duration of the programme.
- Final decision pertaining to attendance/leave of absence and related grievances will be taken by the Senior Director.

SPORTS AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The institute encourages the participation of participants in sports & extracurricular activities but without disturbing the academic work/schedule. However, leaves for participation will be granted on a case-to-case basis.

DRESS CODE

The formal dress code is compulsory on all working days (Monday – Friday) except Saturday. Once the ID Card is issued, it is 100% mandatory to carry ID Card in the Institute Premises.

Institute ERP

AccSoft provides a way to the students/Parents to access their internal mark as well as their day to day attendance by using their exclusive login ID and password. Students should check their marks like attendance, assignment, internal tests, extra mural lectures(EML), Seminar presentation etc. AccSoft also incorporates high security in its system.

INTERNAL TESTS AND ASSIGNMENTS

The detailed Internal Assessment Scheme is notified for all the programs. Students should check the same from the notice board and through E-notice displayed on-line in student login. Student can login to their account through Institute's website www.pimrindore.ac.in.

Students are required to submit their assignments on specified dates as announced in the class by the faculty. Late submission will not be accepted in any case.

Students should note the Internal Test schedule carefully and ensure that they appear in the entire test on time.

Application for absence is accepted only on medical grounds. Students should submit application of absence with medical/medication document/evidence to the Faculty Coordinator-Internal Assessment/Attendance to coordinator. Final decision is taken by the designated committee in consultation with Director.

For any queries students are required to contact Coordinator-Internal Assessment.

PROJECTS

All the students will be assigned faculty supervisors for the summer/ final projects.

All the students are required to meet their supervisors at least six times for the final project and record the notes of discussion.



If a student fails to follow the instructions of the supervisor, then his/her project will not be cleared by the supervisor.

The projects are required to be submitted as per the dates announced. Requests for extension will not be entertained.

DISCIPLINE

Conduct of the students in their classes as well as in the premises of the Institute shall be such as will cause no disturbance to fellow students or to other classes.

Students should not loiter or congregate in the lobbies and foyer while the classes are in progress.

Students must take proper care of the Institute's property and help in keeping the premises neat and clean. Any damage done to the property of the Institute will have to be made good by the concerned students.

In the name and premises of the Institute no association, organization etc. shall be formed, no collection be made, no tickets be sold, no function or meeting be held, no person be invited to address the students, no social gathering be arranged nor anything be printed and/or circulated without written permission of the Director. No notice shall be put on the notice boards nor announcement be made without the Director's written permission.

Students should in their own interest read the notices/E-notices including the notice containing rules placed on the notice boards from time to time.

Every association/council/club/organization etc. formed under the auspices of the Institute is in the charge of a Faculty Member nominated by the Director. Students shall submit all the relevant notices, applications etc. only through the concerned faculty.

All meetings, functions, programs, social gatherings, picnics etc. of all the authorised and duly constituted associations, societies, councils etc. of the Institute must be organised/conducted under the supervision and control of the Director. Agenda, subjects of debates and lectures as the case may be must



have the prior approval of the Director. Similarly, the matter published in the Institute's magazine and notice boards must have the advance approval of the Director.

Students should not engage themselves in any political activity in the Institute's premises.

Students should not communicate or write about any matter dealing with the Institute's administration to the press without prior permission of the Director in writing.

Students are not allowed to use mobile phones within the premises of the Institute.

Ragging in any form is prohibited in the Institute and strict disciplinary action would be taken against students indulging in it and maybe handed over to the Police.

HOSTELS

Students wishing to stay in the hostels should pay the fee in Accounts Department. After payment of fee, the students should contact the concerned Warden for allotment of rooms. The rooms are allotted on first come first serve basis.

Student has toto pay Hostel Fees for entire year when he/she takes admission in hostel.

Hostel fee should be deposited during the first week of July or January or at the start of semester.

Hostel fees are not refundable under any circumstances to the students.

Once the student has availed the facility for hostel, he/she will have to stay for a full academic year and in case of leaving the hostel on the completion of academic year the student will have to give two-month notice.



SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY & GUIDELINES

With the growing presence of social media in our lives, we share a lot of information via conversations on the internet. Social media communication can have an impact on the reputation of individuals as well as that of the organization. The institute has an in-house Committee for Content Management (C4CM), solely responsible for approving and uploading any message, posters, audios, and videos about the institute, its programs, and events. At the same time, PIMR has put together abroad set of guidelines that all participants, staff, and faculty should keep in mind if they carry the PIMR brand on their internet profiles. This is to help everyone make the right choices on social media, for themselves and the institute, keeping in mind that we are all ambassadors of the brand PIMR.

This document outlines the following:

- 1. Guidelines when mentioning PIMR in personal profiles
- 2. Guidelines when managing social media handles on behalf of PIMR

1. When PIMR is mentioned in personal profiles

Keep the following guidelines in mind before posting anything on personal social media handles:

- i. Online can mean forever: Remember that what you post is accessible long after you remove it. Also, comments can be forwarded or copied. Years from now, current or prospective employers can find your posts. They may use this information to ascertain your maturity, and if it is not something you would say to an employer in person, you should think twice about posting it online.
- ii. No view is personal in today's digital world. So even if you comment or write something controversial on social media, thinking it's your personal view, followers of your posts by association can link it back to your place of work or study and judge those institutions as well.
- iii. Respect others.Don't infringe on the privacy of your friends, peers, or faculty. Please do not post personal information of others that could be embarrassing to them or the institute. If posting photos, ask the permission of those involved. If someone objects to your use of an image, avoid using it.



- iv. Communications made in a personal capacity through social media must not:
- Use **PIMR's logo** on any private social media sites
- Include anything that could be considered discriminatory against, bullying, or harassment of any individual.
- Make offensive or derogatory comments, spew personal abuse, insult, spread hatred, communalize or discriminate against any person, state, religion, country, race, gender, disability, sexual orientation, belief, or age. Doing so will make you liable to be punished according to institute rulesand state and central laws.
- Posting or sharing images, audios, videos, or anything that are discriminatory/offensive or links to such content
- Depict or encourage unacceptable, violent, illegal, or dangerous activities, e.g., sexual Harassment or assault, fighting, vandalism, academic dishonesty, drunk and disorderly behavior, drug use, etc., through posting pictures, videos, or comments
- Breach of copyright.
- Breachofcybercrime law of the country
- v. When things go wrong If you have indeed posted something, which has been construed as offensive, the consequences can range from mild to very serious. Reach out to the program office to help you deal with the issue in the best possible manner.
- vi. If your social media views are **controversial**, please **remove your association** with PIMR from your profile.
- vii. **Always think before you write.** Anything that you write on social media is a reflection of your personality, your educational background, and your upbringing. If your content is considered insensitive, it reflects poorly on the institution where you are currently enrolled.
- viii. Always be polite and respectful in all your social media interactions. You can agree or disagree with others healthily, befitting your education, personality, family, professional, and the institutes/workplace you represent. No matter what your views are, you can choose to post them following the societal rules of acceptable discourse and healthy debate.



- ix. Use privacy settings. Understand and use the privacy settings on social networking sites. If you do not, your personal information is available to the entire world. For example, do not provide personal identifying information such as date of birth, phone numbers, home addresses, class schedules, etc.
- x. **Exercise caution.** Be aware of who you add as a friend to your site. Do not allow someone else to create and manage accounts on your behalf.
- xi. Get connected and use social media to change your professional and personal life positively. Social media is a great way to learn about and connect with new people and communities. Search out those people and groups you want to learn more about and connect with them. In addition, you can use social media to understand better a subject you're interested in or explore your creative interests and career goals.
- xii. Prestige Institute of Management & Research, Indore affiliation should be mentioned in all external communication.
- xiii. When writing for external platforms, please note that 'Views are personal."
- xiv. Professional Whatsapp groups should not share unverified, discriminatory, or inflammatory content.
- xv. Personal social media handles must not carry the PIMR name in the users

2. PIMR Social Media account must-have: Username

- Include PIMR before the department or program name. This increases credibility. Please don't make it too long or split it.
- Be consistent with your username and use it across all the platforms
- Use the central communication team for help with this

 Include PIMR in front of your department or program. This increases credibility and brand recognition. Use abbreviation of your prog/ department if there is a problem withthecharacter limit.

Bio / Profile Description

- Always mention that you are affiliated with @PIMR
- Include a link to your webpage
- Include specific information about what your department or team does.
- Provide contact information if there is space allotted for it.

Profile Photo

- Profile photos should be shared with the central team, so there is no duplication.
- Use the same profile photo across all platforms.

Cover Photo and Header

• Cover photos should be customized to specific departments and programs, such as a shot of your participants, facilities, or the campus.
