1. Minutes of last Meeting and ATRs held on December 23, 2019 were confirmed.
2. Dr. Yogeshwari Phatak, Director shared information regarding submission of Self Study Report for Third Cycle of Accreditation on NAAC Portal along with the assessment fee on February 01, 2020.
3. Information being shared by Dr. Deepak Jaroliya regarding the workshop conducted for mentee institutions on NAAC Accreditation Process under UGC PARAMARSH Scheme (February 12, 2020). During the workshop participants were briefed about the Mentoring Plan Document and then it was followed with group wise round table discussion.
4. Report of International conference being shared that was successfully organized in January 2020 and there were three tie-ups for paper publication include the South Asian Journal of Management (Scopus Listed and 'C' Category Journal among ABDC List of Journals), Book 'Advances in Emerging Markets and Business Operations' by Taylor and Francis, and Indore Management Journal of IIM, Indore. 5. AICTE approved FDP on Leadership and Motivation successfully organized on December 10-23, 2019. Chairman of AICTE Dr. Anil D. Sahastrabudhe graced the event on December 17, 2019. The Institute received 77 applications of interested participants from all over India (Bihar, Assam, Rajasthan, M.P., U.P., Karnataka, Jharkhand, Haryana). Applications from Sharjahan and Bahrain were also received. Only 40 participants shortlisted (including internal and external participants) to attend the FDP.
6. Good Governance Cell of Prestige Institute of Management and Research, Indore is actively involved in Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojna (SAGY), Central Government Scheme. Under this scheme, at initial level, the SAGY baseline Survey was conducted by the team of Good Governance Cell, PIMR Indore. This survey was conducted to analyse the present condition of the village before the development activities under Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojna. There were various parameters in the questionnaire which were filled, to analyse the requirements of the village and on the basis of analysis the development and other required activities will be planned in "Village Development Plan" to make this adopted village as "Model Village".
7. The consultancy proposal was received by Dr. Pallavi Kapooria from TATA Trust (TRIF- Transform Rural India Foundation) under the "Sarathi Programme" for conducting a project titled 'A Job Forecast in the Pithampur Special Economic Zone' for the next 3 years. The objective is to analyze the kind of jobs that would be generated and the kind of skilled manpower the industries would be looking for.
8. Information being shared that the Good Governance Cell is organizing Innovation Based Competition named as "One M.P. One Idea Competition". This competition was as per the guidelines of MPLADS, developed by Central Government of India. This competition was monitored by the District Collector of Indore City along with the committee members from various Grade I Government Officers from various departments. Dr. Deepak Jaroliya In-charge of Good Governance Cell being appointed as one of the member of committee.

9. IQAC appreciated that the institute is taking initiative to plan alternate arrangements for online teaching via Zoom software. Faculty members were informed to get familiar with the same.
